Post-operative instructions for

Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy

Diet

1. It is ok to resume a regular diet with no restrictions as tolerated.

Activity

- 1. It is ok to climb stairs, walk to the mailbox, etc. as tolerated.
- 2. Do not drive until you are off narcotic pain medication and able to steer, press the brakes, etc. without pain.
- 3. Do not lift over 20 lbs. for six weeks from the surgery date.
- 4. You may resume sexual activity when you feel comfortable.

Wound care

- 1. It is ok to shower the day after your operation. Let the water hit and bounce off the steri-strip bandages. Pat yourself dry with a towel.
- 2. Do not take a tub bath.
- 3. You can change the outer dressing if needed, but leave the small white steri-strips in place until your post-op appointment.
- 4. Some bruising around the incisions is normal.

Drain care

If you have a drain, make sure you empty and record the drainage amounts daily, as directed.

Follow-up

- 1. Follow-up in the office in 14 days for staple removal/post-op. This appointment should be in your black folder given to you in the office. If your appointment was after-hours and you did not receive a black folder, the office should call you with a post-op appointment; if they do not, please call us to schedule one.
- 2. Call the office for any of the following:
 - -nausea or vomiting
 - -fever > 101.5°
 - -pain unrelieved with prescribed pain medication
 - -wounds that are red or draining fluid
 - -diarrhea > 10 times a day
 - -inability to have a bowel movement by seven days after surgery
 - -inability to urinate

You must consult with your physician upon your post operative appointment regarding returning to work.
